Der Walzer Morgengeläute von Martin Heinrichs wurde bereits 2007 für die „Kapelle Grausig“, der kleinen Blechbläserbesetzung der Stadtkapelle Rottweil, komponiert und immer wieder gerne aufgeführt. Das Stück beschreibt ein Stimmungsbild einer Szene an der sich an einem frühen Sonntagmorgen auf einer Bergwiese der Klang der Kuhglocken mit dem vom Tal her schallenden Geläute der nahen Dorfkirchen vereint. Alle Menschen sind festlich angetan denn nach dem Gebet wird zum Dorftanz aufgespielt. Die Musik beginnt bereits zu spielen noch bevor der Schall des großen Geläutes verklungen ist.

Wie schon in der Originalkomposition als auch in dem vorliegenden Arrangement für ganzes Blasorchester verweben sich die Motive des erhabenen Talblicks und dem Dorftanz. Dies wird unterlegt mit dem Klang des Morgengeläutes zu dem Stimmungsbild eines sonnigen Festtages. Es darf getanzt werden.

The waltz Morgengeläute by Martin Heinrichs was composed back in 2007 for the “Kapelle Grausig”, the small brass ensemble of the Stadtkapelle Rottweil, and has been performed time and time again. This piece describes an atmospheric scene in which the sound of cowbells on a mountain meadow on an early Sunday morning is combined with the ringing of the nearby village churches from the valley. All people are in a festive mood as the village dance begins after the prayer. The music begins to play even before the sound of the great bells has faded.

As in the original composition as well as in the present arrangement for full wind orchestra, the motifs of the sublime view of the valley and the village dance, underpinned by the sound of the morning bells, interweave to create the mood of a sunny festive day. You can have a dance.
